2. Please make sure you are fully informed of the requirements for the program you are applying to as well as the location of the faculty to which your intended major belongs to.

3. If a student does not meet the language requirement or submits an incomplete application, his/her application may be rejected before being proceeded to the next phase. In this case, the application and its fee are not be able to return. (General - TOPIK level 4, Arts and Physical - TOPIK level 3)
4. **The letter of recommendation** should be from an instructor in the institution you last attended. It must be signed by the instructor himself/herself.
5. **Financial Affidavit**: Official bank statement is required on bank letterhead. Please show an available balance in 20,000,000 KRW(minimum). For applicants currently residing in Korea, the account must be a Korean bank account. For applicants currently residing outside of Korea, the account must be a foreign bank account.
6. **For applicants who are scheduled for the performance test**, supplementary materials must be sent in advance along with other application documents (i.e. portfolio, CDs, DVDs, etc.)
7. If a student who did not fulfill the requirements or not passed for evaluation for a thesis, may be required to register for additional semesters to meet the graduation requirements.
8. **Transfer admission** : only available for students who have been enrolled or who are currently enrolled in the Korean Graduate School(s). (Not acceptable for students who were enrolled in or graduated from overseas universities.)
9. **Please note**:
  - ✓ The application fee is not refundable. Submitted documents will not be returned even when the applicant is not accepted.
  - ✓ Evaluation scores will not be disclosed.
  - ✓ Documents written in languages other than Korean or English must be translated into Korean and evaluated by an approved agency. (Originals also must be submitted.)
  - ✓ If any information provided by the applicant in the application is found to be false, the application will be rejected and any offer of enrollment will be withdrawn.
  - ✓ Any offer of enrollment will be withdrawn if the applicant who has not yet been conferred a Bachelor's degree at the time of submitting the application fails to submit his/her Certificate of Graduation by the designed date.

#### A. Graduate school

- 1) Students may write their thesis in either English or Korean, but the thesis language must be approved by the student's adviser in advance.
- 2) Students must complete the requirements for courses before taking the comprehensive exam.
- 3) Students must complete the requirements for both courses and thesis before writing a thesis (including thesis evaluation).  
Those who have not fulfilled requirements or who have not passed their thesis may be required to register for additional semesters to meet the graduation requirements.
- 4) If the student's major in his/her previous academic degree is different from the major he/she is now applying for, maximum 12 credits may be additionally required (prerequisite courses). The student must complete all prerequisite courses to graduate and obtain the degree. (Those who have submitted the official TOPIK test result for admission are not applicable with the above.)

- ※ [Graduate School of Social Welfare] Students who plan to write a thesis must take 2 pre-required courses: Social Welfare Research(3<sup>rd</sup> semester) and Social Welfare Data Analysis(4<sup>th</sup> semester)
- ※ [Graduate School of Integrative Therapy] Those students who considering obtaining a "Certificate of Lifelong Education" must take 16 major credits and five credits in the teacher training category in advance.  
If those who decide not to write a thesis, they are required to take additional 6 credits.
- ※ Graduate School of Education: 16 major credits and 8 credits (in the category of teacher training). If those who decide not to write a thesis, they are required to take additional 6 elective credits.
- ※ Comprehensive Exam: Only available for students who have average GPA of minimum 3.0 (minimum 18 credits) and who have also completed at least 4 semesters including those who are in their 4<sup>th</sup> semester.
